**Subject: Demand for Due Process and Justice in the Case of LTC Michael Kelvington**

I'm writing to you as an American citizen, a voter, and someone who still believes in the ideals of fairness, due process, and accountability—especially within the institutions that ask men and women to risk everything for this country.

His case reflects a disturbing trend—where uncorroborated accusations, political pressure, and manipulated investigations carry more weight than facts, evidence, and earned honor.

Investigators in this case ignored exculpatory evidence, violated Rule for Courts-Martial 707 by over 100 days, and even **altered completed findings** to fit predetermined conclusions. The end result has been public humiliation, professional destruction, and a denial of medical retirement—all without a fair chance to defend himself.

This is not how justice is supposed to work in a nation founded on the rule of law. If a decorated officer like LTC Kelvington can be discarded this easily, then the precedent being set should concern every American, military or civilian.

I urge you to act. Please stand with the **Justice for Warriors Caucus** and demand:

1. A formal inquiry into the Army's handling of LTC Kelvington's case.
2. Immediate dismissal of the charges and reinstatement of his medical retirement.
3. Accountability for those in the chain of command who manipulated or obstructed due process.
4. Broader oversight of how political agendas and internal programs are being used to circumvent basic rights.

If the system is not held accountable in this case, the damage extends far beyond one man or one family—it undermines public trust in the entire institution.

We need leaders in Washington who are willing to stand for principle, not just politics. This is your opportunity to be one of them.
